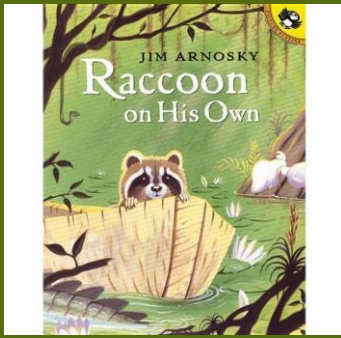


# BOOK ACTIVITIES

## LET'S CRAFT TOGETHER



### Footprint Raccoon

Materials needed: child's foot, gray, white, and black paint, and a black marker, paper, and paint brush (optional).

Parents can assist children with rubbing their foot in the paint. Children will then press foot on the paper. Children can then use index finger in black paint to add stripes on the tail. Children will use marker to draw mouth, eyes, and ears on the raccoon.
