			1 Look online for different signs that you may see in your community. Talk to your child about the signs found.	2 Help your child notice road signs, while riding in the car. Name the different road signs and discuss the color and shapes of the signs.
5 Walk around the school to look for signs and discuss each sign.	6 Read a book aloud to your child. Ask them to scribble or draw their favorite character from the book you read.	7 Show your child a picture of a stop sign and ask, "Why are all stop signs red?" Assist your child with drawing and naming the shape.	8 Show your child a speed limit sign, and ask questions such as, "What number is on this sign?" Then practice writing the number using the magic board	9 While at the grocery store, have your child identify the labels of their favorite foods.
12 Take a walk around your neighborhood and take pictures (pretend play with viewfinder) of the signs you see.	13 Discuss with your child, what types of items you buy in each kind of store. (grocery store, shoe store, clothing store, etc.)	14 Talk about how signs help you know where to find things.	15 Have your child identify the food labels in the kitchen and make a label using playdoh.	16 After reading a book, discuss the similarities and differences between characters.
19 Help your child to create a toy sign using their Magic Board.	20 While outside, take a walk in your neighborhood and identify the shapes of different signs.	21 Introduce the word traffic as cars move together on a road.	22 Ask your child, "Why do some signs have words on them?" Talk to them about their answers.	23 Ask your child to choose a book and read the book aloud to them. Ask questions during the story.
26 While outside, play a game of "Red Light, Green Light."	27 Use the lacing shapes to identify the shapes of signs .	28 Read a book aloud to your child. Ask them to scribble or draw their favorite character from the book you read.	29 Let your child pick out a book to read and summarize what happened in the story.	30 Show your child a speed limit sign, and ask questions such as, "What number is on the sign?"
