May 2021

Talk to your child about how there are different types of bags and that bags are used to carry things in. Find them examples to see.

May 3 **MO**

Give your child pencils, crayons, and markers and a paper bag. Help your child draw on the paper bag.

May 4 **TU**

May 5 **WE**

Talk to your child about different types of bags like paper, plastic, and how they can be used. Join your child it finding different bags around the house.

May 6 **TH**

Lunch Outside
Pack your lunches for you and your child to eat outdoors. Talk about the things you put in the bag and the things that you are eating for lunch.

May 7 **FR**

Using a paper and plastic bag, ask your child to tell you the difference between the two (2) bags. Help your child see which one can hold more.

May 10 **MO**

Place a few items in a bag and let your child put their hand in the bag to feel around without looking. Ask them to tell you the items that they are feeling in the bag.

May 11 **TU**

Allow your child to pick their favorite book and read a book each night before bedtime.

May 12 **WE**

Use a paper bag and place small objects in it like rice, beans, beads, or small rocks. Use a rubber band or strong tape to secure the end. Let your child use the bag like an instrument to make music.

May 13 **TH**

May 14 **FR**

Gather a small Zip-lock bag and place beans in the bag to make a beanbag. Let your child play toss with the bag. Be sure to secure the end with strong tape and/or hot glue. Keep for other activities throughout the month.

May 17 **MO**

Allow your child to use a small brown paper bag and ball it up as small as they can to make a ball. Go outside with your child and join them in playing toss and catch.

May 18 **TU**

Talk to your child about different kinds of bags and their uses. Like a purse, recycled grocery bag, backpack, camera bag, medicine bag, and computer bag. See what bags you can find around the house.

May 19 **WE**

Tell your child to pretend to go shopping. Ask your child to gather their favorite things. Pretend to work as a cashier ringing up items and placing them in their bag to take home.

Using a suitcase, talk with your child about how it is sometimes called a bag because you can put things in it. Help your child see how many things can be put in the suitcase.

Provide your child with a garbage bag. Take a walk around the neighborhood and help your child to pick things up that should not be on the ground. Talk about taking care of where they live.

May 26 **WE**

Provide your child with paper, markers, crayons, and/or pencils. Help your child to draw a picture of things they would pack in their suitcase or bag to go on a trip. Ask them questions about their drawings.
